This was such an overwhelming success and appreciated by the residents; the association board is hoping to make it an annual event as a benefit to the Home Place community.

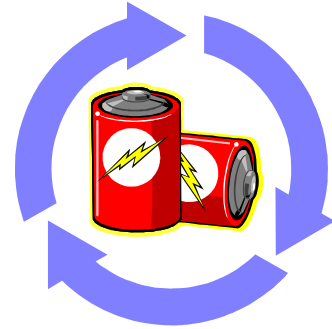
# USED BATTERY COLLECTION SITE

Doug says that John has a true appreciation and respect for cemeteries and for those who have gone before us. "It is important to watch for anyone who might be causing destruction, especially in the old pioneer cemeteries. Respect is important - - someone's families are there."

Our cemetery has some special history as Isaac Sharp is buried there. Mr. Sharp founded Home Place, and donated the first bit of land at the corner of 106<sup>th</sup> & College for a meeting house/school/church. He was also the last surviving veteran of the war of 1812.
